
## 47% of Federal Civil Caseload is in MDLs Where the FRCP Are Not Designed to Apply




At the end of fiscal year 2017, 46.7% of civil cases in the federal court system were in MDLs.[1]

266,108 cases were pending in the federal court system.

124,202 of these cases were pending in 256 MDLs.<sup>[2]</sup>
